Significant enhancements in AS 5.6 give more control to project admins

Source Code Commits

By adding simple keys in the subject line of your code commit, you can now create an association to any number of artifacts in the Gforge database, including specific WIKI pages, forum posts, documents and others as well as the existing tracker item links.

GUI Enhancements

More GUI enhancements were made in this release, including Cancel/Back buttons added throughout the system. Delete confirmation forms also now include the title and ID# of the item being deleted.

More fine-grained access controls

Documents now have folder-level permissions to control access for members and non-members and FRS Packages now each have their own permission controls as well.

Subversion repositories can now assign "No access" permission on a per-user basis.

Best-of-class Forum Features

GForge AS now includes best-of-class forum features like sticky threads, locked threads and message moderation for forum administrators on a per-forum basis. This is in addition to the per-forum access controls that are role-based.

More RSS Feeds

More RSS feeds have been added at the site level to add to the project-level RSS feeds that already exist. Site-level news and forum feeds will help your users stay in touch with what is happening across all projects.
